

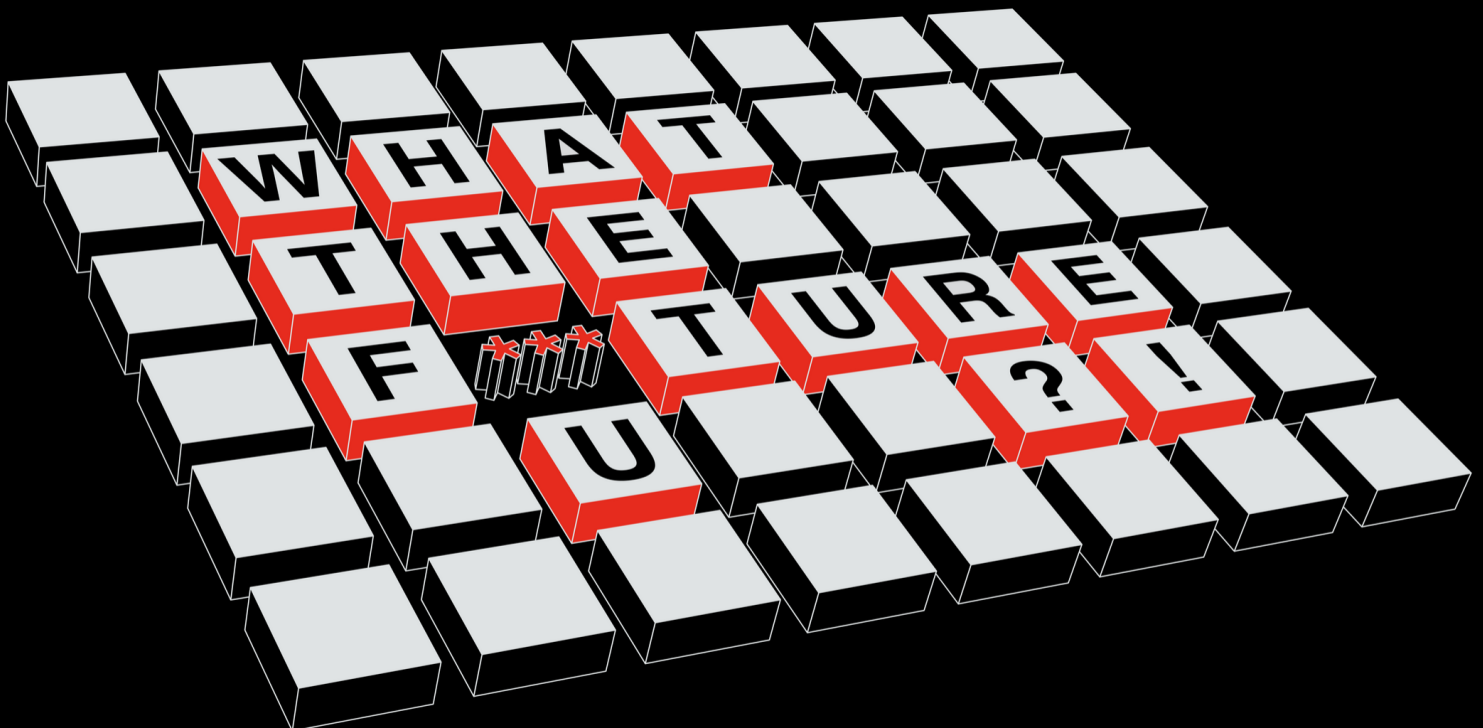

In order to secure our future and that of our children and generations to come we will need new ways of thinking and fundamentally change the way we make decisions and our choices.

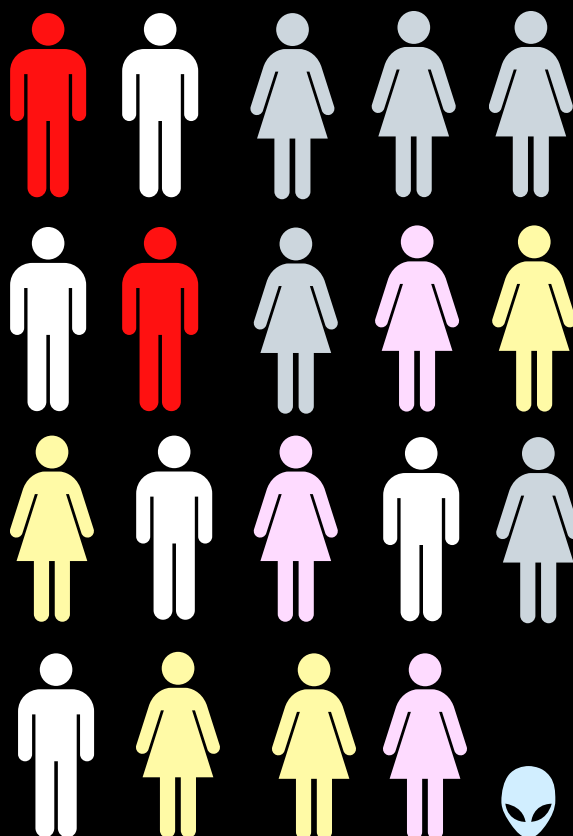
In other words we need to start a new conversations that matter on how to incorporate futures thinking into our present decisions.

Left in coma, with more fractured bones than you can count on two hands, dislocated joints, internal failures, cerebral bleeding and other brain injuries she is considered a medical mystery.

ANNA SIRCOVA

For over 20 years now she is curious about the concept of time, which she does research and creative projects about. Her research focuses on how people perceive time of their life, what are their attitudes towards their own past, present and future, how they make decisions based on that and how it impacts their well-being among other things.



ANNA SITNIKOVA AND ELIZAVETA GLUKHOVA

The designers and art curators Anna and Elizaveta work in close collaboration with International Lunar Exploration Working Group at the European Space Agency. In response to one of the biggest challenges of space exploration – a disparity between big ideas and resources for their realisation, they encourage to think big but small.

As Moon Gallery project leaders they are developing a 10 x 10 cm miniature gallery of 100 artworks and artifacts to be sent to the Moon in 2022. Through a series of open calls and space art sessions at international conferences, they are gathering ideas that are worth promoting into the future.

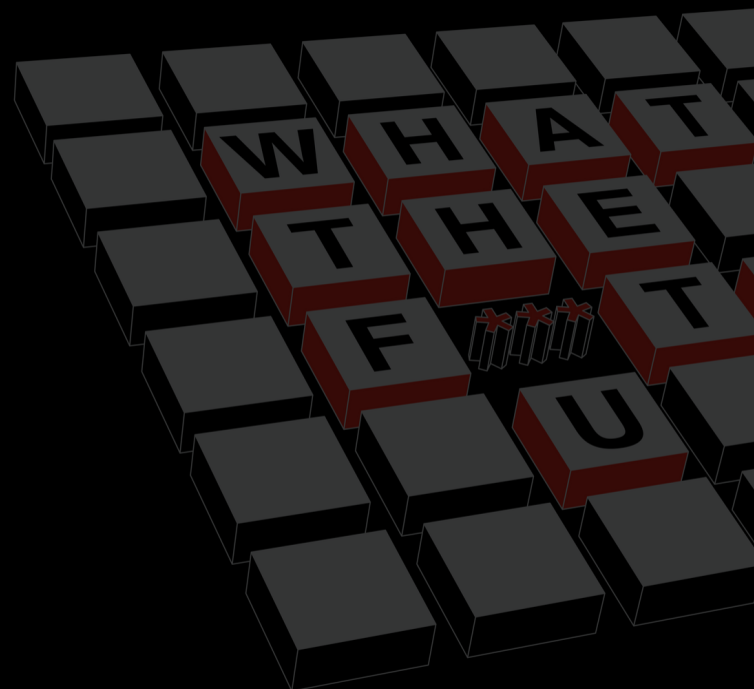
MAYA VAN LEEMPUT

Her critical forward-looking work on media, culture, arts, (cross-cultural) communication, development, science and technology in society and urban environments, uses experimental, creative and participatory approaches. She partners with photographer Bram Goots on Agence Future (AF), a long-term independent project for futures exploration. This interdisciplinary collaboration combines conversation based approaches and visual ethnography with the co-creation of images of the future.

Maya is a fellow of the World Futures Studies Federation and the Centre of Postnormal Policy and Futures Studies, a member the Association of Professional Futurists and the interdisciplinary visual arts collective OST. As the senior researcher of the centre of expertise Open Time | Applied Futures Research she also teaches Strategic Futures Orientation to final year Bachelor students in Idea and Innovation Management students.
